Parents/Guardians of Students at Global Impact (Current 9th, 10th and 11th grade students):

We are coming into a busy time for College Credit Plus (CCP), and I will be relaying information to students and families in several different ways. Hard copy letters can be sent home for most material that needs a signature and returned to school. Emails to parents and students, posting College Credit Plus (CCP) information to the website, Remind messages, and meetings may also be used.

Anyone planning on taking College Credit Plus (CCP) courses next year (2022-23) must complete the following items before April 1, 2023:

1. Watch the **CCP Update Video 2023-24** located on the front page of the GISA Website (globalimpactacademy.org).
2. Read the **CCP Annual Information Session** PowerPoint located in the College Credit Plus portion of the GISA website.
3. Complete the **CCP Letter of Intent/Agreement** for 2023-2024 found in the College Credit Plus portion of the GISA website. This needs to be submitted **annually** for any student who will be taking college credit plus courses the upcoming year.

Please complete the **CCP Letter of Intent/Agreement** online on the GISA website by March 20. A signature is needed from both parent and student on the digital form. Alternatively, the form can be printed off the website, signed, and returned to the school by March 20, 2023.

All 9th, 10th and 11th grade students should submit the letter of intent form because there is an opportunity that the student may be taking college classes during the 2023-2024 school year

Parent-Teacher Conferences will be held February 16 and 17, and I will be available for questions and appointments. Please contact me to schedule a face to face or virtual appointment at mhess@gisaoh.org.

Students will begin selecting college courses for next fall semester in March. Those students who qualify as college ready as determined by either Accuplacer testing or grades, and have successfully completed English 2, will have the opportunity to tell us their plan when we meet with them about scheduling. Students who enroll in college English may also choose to start a language (ASL 1111 or Spanish 1111). If we cannot offer the Accuplacer, course grade and GPA will be used to determine eligibility. All students who have taken college courses previously will also be scheduling for next fall semester in March.
